Saddle. Asking \$1,550. Purchased new in 2006 and in excellent condition. Made in England by Frank Barnes Saddlery. It is black with a relatively flat seat which avoids restricting the rider. It is considered a "General Purpose" dressage saddle and it works well for riders who also do trail riding and enjoy small jumps. It has three widely spaced girth billets with short billet straps and adjustable/removeable knee blocks.
